- 2. Bailey adopted Brimstone.
- 3. Brimstone is the black mustang.
- 4. Casey chose the roan mustang from McGavin Peak.
- 5. Alex did not adopt Brimstone or Cricket.
- 6. Dusty came from the Utah herd at Onaqui Mountain.
- 7. Alex adopted the mustang from Sand Wash Basin.
